

## **NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**

### **THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (MARKET STREET, WATFORD) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for Hertfordshire County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County under Sections 1,2,3, 32, 38, 61, 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as “the Act”) and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Order will be:

- (A) Convert Bus Stop “G” located adjacent to NatWest Bank to No Waiting at Any Time except Taxis, for 24 metres.
- (B) Convert the Bus Stand located outside 13-21 to a Bus Stop Clearway.
- (C) Reduce the Existing loading bay outside 23 -25 by 2 metres in length to allow for the extension of bus stop cage
- (D) Introduce No Waiting & No Loading At Any Time restrictions at the junction of High Street & Market Street.
