**Re: Proposed extension of No Waiting at Any Time on North Approach**

The Council has received requests from residents and elected members regarding the reduced visibility levels for drivers travelling along the carriageway west of the Kingsway Infants School, on North Approach.

Due to the nature of the carriageway which bends between Kingsway Infants School and no. 255, the high vegetation at the location and parked vehicles, the visibility for drivers is obscured resulting in a safety concern for both drivers and pedestrians.

It is therefore proposed to extend the existing no waiting at any time (double yellow line) restrictions 5m in the western direction and 3m in the eastern direction, in the interests of road safety.

A plan (Drawing Reference WR22TRO2118/IF/ST6) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
