**Re: Proposed changes to parking restrictions on Briar Rd/Meadow Rd junction**

The Council has received a number of requests from concerned residents and elected members regarding obstructive and inconsiderate parking taking place on the No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on the Briar Road junction with Meadow Road.

Parking which occurs in this area, means that pedestrians are unable to safely use the footway, which creates a hazard for pedestrians including parents with school children using the area. Parking at the junction obscures the visibility for other drivers, and creates a safety issue for all modes of traffic.

It is therefore proposed that a No Loading at Any Time restriction is added to the existing No Waiting at Any Time restriction, at this location.

A plan (Drawing Reference WR22TRO2118/IF/ST2) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
