**Re: Proposed changes to waiting restrictions on Woodmere Avenue, from the junction with Douglas Avenue**

The Council has received requests from elected members regarding complaints raised by residents concerning vehicles indiscriminately parking on the footway and carriageway which reduces their visibility of on-coming traffic from the junction.

Vehicles parked on the footway/carriageway so close to the junction, particularly on the western side, raises a safety issue for road users in the area.

To improve visibility and safety, It is therefore proposed to extend the existing No Waiting At Any Time restriction from the junction in the interests of road safety. This will also ensure it is in line with guidance set out within the Highway Code which indicates that vehicles should not park at or within 10 metres of a junction. A plan (Drawing Reference WR22/1F/TD1) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
