### **Informal Consultation on extension to Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) V.**

Your local Ward Councillors have been contacted by residents who have requested that the section of Cassiobury Drive, which is currently outside of the CPZ, should now be included within the Zone.

As you will be aware, parking on the section of carriageway on Cassiobury Drive between Langley Way and Bellmount Wood Avenue is currently unrestricted, which enables vehicles to park long term without having a permit.

To ensure the views of residents and businesses in this section are considered, we are carrying out this short informal consultation to understand the level of support from those properties within the road, which will be most affected by any changes.

It is proposed that "Past this Point" signs are used, similar to those already seen on Cassiobury Drive to the north of Bellmount Wood Avenue, so no further road markings will be required. To ensure a consistent approach to markings, the section of single yellow line (No Waiting Monday-Saturday 8am-6.30pm) will be removed, which will enable an increase in use of kerb side space, for parking.

Short term parking for non-permit holders will still be available around the roundabout and local centre, and this proposal only affects the area between Langley Way and Bellmount Wood Avenue.

If there was support for the proposals, this would mean vehicles parked on street would need to have a permit to park during the scheme hours which operate Monday to Friday 10am-2.30pm, between the 1<sup>st</sup> September and 30<sup>th</sup> June. Upon conclusion of the informal consultation, all responses received will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and your local Ward Councillors prior to any decision being made on whether or not to proceed to the final statutory consultation stage. Once a decision has been made we will write to you again to inform you of this outcome.
