<u>Woodmere Avenue, from the junction with Douglas Avenue – Statutory consultation on proposed</u> <u>extension of waiting restrictions</u>

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in December 2022.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to extend the existing No Waiting At Any Time restriction in the south-western direction from the junction in the interests of road safety and to ensure consistency with guidance set out within the Highway Code which indicates that vehicles should not park at or within 10 metres of a junction.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WR23/SC/TD1) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 17**th **February 2023**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to TID@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 10**th **March 2023**.

All comments will be considered by Ward Councillors and officers prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
