Re: Trinity Hall Close – Statutory Consultation on the proposed removal of limited waiting restrictions and introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in July 2023.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to only proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to extend the existing No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) on the northern side from the junction with St. Pauls Way and around the carriageway pinch-point outside property number 7 to deter parking. The existing single yellow line restrictions, which operates Monday to Friday 10 – 11am, on the road are to remain as they are.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WR23/SC/TD2) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 6th October 2023**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to TID@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is **23:59 on Friday 27th October 2023**.

All comments will be considered by Ward Councillors and officers prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
