**Statutory Consultation on extension to Permit Parking Area (PPA) Zone NA to include Gammons Lane (section west of St George's Road)**

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents between November and December 2023. The Portfolio Holder and your local Ward Councillors reviewed all the feedback received and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on the proposals to include the section of Gammons Lane (west of St. George's Road) within Zone NA. The results and summary of informal consultation can be found on the council website at [Gammons Lane Zone - NA Extension – www.watford.gov.uk](http://www.watford.gov.uk)

This will mean that vehicles parked on street, in this area, will need to have a permit during the Controlled Parking Zone NA scheme hours which will operate between Monday to Saturday 8am to 10am and 5pm to 10pm (including Bank Holidays).

It is proposed that "Past this Point" signs are used which would imply that Zone NA permit holder signs will be located just west of St George's Road. The existing sections of double yellow lines (No Waiting at any time) at the junction with St George's Road and within the turning head area will remain in place. This is in the interests of road safety and accessibility for larger vehicles including refuse collection vehicles and fire tenders.

The proposals are shown on the drawing enclosed (WBC/PPA/NA/GL/02). Further information on the zone and permit eligibility can be found on the council website at [www.watford.gov.uk/parking](http://www.watford.gov.uk/parking).

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2024**. As this is a legal process, representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Lead Officer, at the address noted above or by email to [parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk](mailto:parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk). The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024**. All comments will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and your local Ward Councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals or not. Once a decision has been made, we will write to you again to inform you of the outcome.
