## <u>Re: Newlands Walk junction with Trevellance Way - Statutory Consultation on proposed</u> <u>introduction of waiting restrictions</u>

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents from 16<sup>th</sup> February to 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on north eastern side of the junction in the interest of road safety.

Following the feedback received, the proposed no waiting at any time restriction on Newlands walk has been reduced from 12 metres to 6 metres, to end on the western boundary of the drive at property no. 1 Newlands Walk. This will still ensure parking is deterred at and close to the junction.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WRR24/SC/WD3) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to <u>parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk</u>. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is **23:59** on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024**.

All comments will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
