<u>Re:</u> Garston Park Parade Service Road - Statutory Consultation on proposed conversion of existing <u>H-bar protection marking with No waiting at any time restrictions</u>

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents from 16th February to 8th March 2024.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to to convert the existing H-bar marking by the dropped kerb outside no. 16 Garston Park Parade to No Waiting at Any Time restrictions to deter parking and improve access to the dropped kerb by vulnerable users such as wheel chair users.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WRR24/SC/ME1) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 12th July 2024**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to <u>parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk</u>.. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is **23:59** on **Friday 2nd August 2024**.

All comments will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
