## Re: Proposed reduction of waiting restrictions on Beechwood Rise, from the junction with Middle Way

The Council has received a number of complaints in relation to the length of the existing double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) restriction on the west side of Beechwood Rose from its junction with Middle Way and have made requests to have it reduced to make provision for more parking spaces.

With the demand for parking in the area being high, particularly in the evenings and on the weekends, reducing the double yellow lines will increase the space available for residents to park.

It is therefore proposed to reduce the existing double yellow lines from 19 metres to 10 metres to create more space for parking.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR24/IF/LE3) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
