**Re: Proposed extension of the existing waiting restrictions on Sheepcot Drive from the junction with Sheepcot Lane**

The Council has received a number of requests from concerned residents and elected members regarding the difficulties drivers are having with accessing the junction when vehicles are parked close to the junction.

Vehicles have been observed to park on both sides of the carriageway which narrows the carriageway, causing an obstruction to traffic flow on approach to the junction and hinders its accessibility for motorists as turning movements can be impeded, particularly for large vehicles.

It is therefore proposed, in the interests of road safety, to extend the length of the existing No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on Sheepcot Drive by 13 metres. This will improve turning movements and encouraging traffic to flow freely at the junction, ultimately improving its accessibility.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR24/IF/ST8) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
