## Re: Proposed introduction of waiting restrictions on Hill Farm Close

The Council has received a number of complaints from residents and elected members regarding vehicles parking on the footway on Hill Farm Close which raises a safety hazard for pedestrians, particularly vulnerable ones such as kids accessing the footpath or crossing the road to go to the playground as their visibility is obscured and they will have to get into the carriageway to go around the parked vehicles.

Due to the carriageway being narrow, the parked cars also obstruct access for other drivers particularly large vehicles and obscure the visibility of other drivers.

It is therefore proposed to introduce No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the road from its junction with Hill Farm Avenue to deter drivers from parking and improve the safety issue for all modes of traffic.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR24/IF/WD1) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
