**Re: Proposed introduction of No Waiting At Any Time on Farmers Close**

Following the consultation which was carried out in November 2021, the Council have continued to review the parking situation in Farmers Close. As parking still occurs which causes an obstruction within the turning head, your local Ward Councillors have agreed to carry out an informal consultation on a shorter section of No Waiting At Any Time (Double Yellow Lines).

Previously, restrictions have been proposed around the whole turning head to deter motorists from parking. However, bearing in mind that the demand for parking on the road is high, it is proposed to introduce a no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) restrictions just around the circular or bulbous end of the turning head. This will deter motorists from parking at that location, ensuring the safe passage of vehicles and allow the turning head to be utilised easily and safely.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR24/IF/WD4) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
