**Re: Middle Way junction with Middle Ope – Statutory Consultation on proposed extension of waiting restrictions on Middle Way**

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents from 29<sup>th</sup> November to 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to extend the existing no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the northern side of Middle Way to 10 meters on either side from the junction. This will deter motorists from parking at or close to the junction on Middle Way and improve the visibility and accessibility for drivers and pedestrians navigating the junction.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WRR24/SC/LE1) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2025**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Services Lead, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to [parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk](mailto:parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk). The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025**.

All the comments received will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
