Re: Balmoral Road (between Sandown Road and the pedestrian crossing) – Statutory Consultation on proposed changes to waiting restrictions

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents from 29th November to 20th December 2024.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to convert the existing No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) between the Sandown Road and the pedestrian crossing west of Bradshaw Road to a single yellow line to operate as No Waiting Monday – Friday 8am – 6.30pm. The aim of this is to increase the parking spaces available for residents to park overnight and on a Sundays when demand for parking by residents is at its highest, and to also ensure that that section carriageway is consistent with the restrictions on the north side of the carriageway.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (**Drawing Reference WRR24/SC/CA1**) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 21st February 2025**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Services Lead, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is **23:59 on Friday 14th March 2025**.

All the comments received will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
