## Re: Hill Farm Close – Statutory Consultation on proposed introduction of waiting restrictions

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents from 29<sup>th</sup> November to 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to introduce No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the road, from the junction with Hill Farm Avenue to deter drivers from parking and improve the safety issue for all modes of traffic at that location.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WRR24/SC/WD1) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 21**<sup>st</sup> **February 2025**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Services Lead, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

All comments received will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
