TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995 AS AMENDED

DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4 (1)

WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Watford being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(4) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on the following list of addresses, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended: **Load of Hay (207) Pinner Road; 6, Royal Oak (25) Watford Heath.**

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4 (1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under article 4 (1) of the said Order and, in accordance with the article 5 (4), shall remain in force until 4th October 2013 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless prior to that date it has been confirmed by the Council.

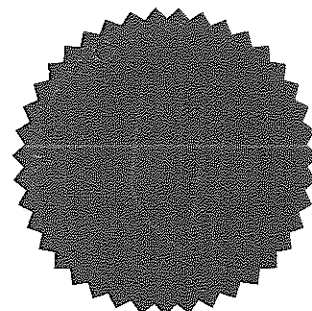



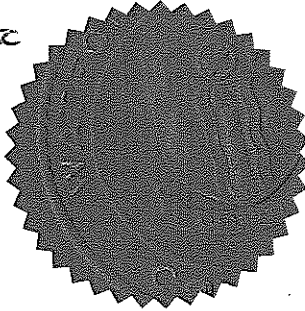
