### **Proposed removal of No Waiting restrictions in the Sandringham Road Area.**

Following the feedback received relating to the informal consultation, which took place in October and November 2021. I write to you again to advise you that following discussions with the elected members and officers that a decision has been to remove the timed no waiting restrictions in your area, including Sandringham Road, Windsor Road, and Osborne Road, and a small section in Buckingham Road, to enable additional kerb side parking space in the area. A plan of the proposals is attached for your reference.

The removal of the lines and signs, associated with the No Waiting restrictions will be carried out week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> February, subject to suitable weather conditions.

There are certain areas where small sections of No Waiting At Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) will need to be applied, to ensure road safety, and these will be promoted via a Traffic Regulation Order. The statutory consultation period will be undertaken from Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February to Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March.

Representations of support or objections to the proposed no waiting at any time together with the grounds on which they are made **must be sent in writing** to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX, or by email to [TID@watford.gov.uk](mailto:TID@watford.gov.uk). The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022**.
