**Re: Proposed extension of No Waiting At Any Time on Middle Way**

The Council has received requests from residents and elected members regarding the visibility levels and access when vehicles are parked near the junction of Middle Way and Beechwood Rise.

Whilst there are existing no waiting at any time (double yellow line) restrictions at the junction, it is proposed that these are extended by a further 10 metres up to the speed cushion on Middle Way to improve driver visibility.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR21/TRO/IF/LE1) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
