**Re: Proposed introduction of No Waiting At Any Time on Gullet Wood Road**

The Council has received requests from residents, Watford Community Housing and elected members regarding the difficulties drivers are having with reduced visibility levels around the junction, when vehicles are parked at the access of Gullet Wood Road, this can also impair access for larger vehicles trying to access properties on Gullet Wood Road.

It is therefore proposed that a no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) are implemented on the north section of Gullet Wood Road between Rushton Avenue & Sparrow Walk, in the interests of road safety.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR21/TRO/IF/ST1) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
