Middle Way/Beechwood Rise – Statutory consultation on proposed changes to waiting restrictions.

Thank you for your feedback and comments, following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in December 2021.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to statutory consultation on proposals to extend the existing No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) restrictions by a further 10 metres up to the speed cushion on Middle Way, and to extend the No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) restrictions into Beechwood Rise. The proposals are shown on the attached drawing for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on Friday 18th February. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX, or by email to TID@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on Friday 11th March 2022.

All comments will be considered by Ward Councillors and officers prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
