**Proposed introduction of No Waiting at Any Time at the junction of St Albans Road with Holland Gardens – Statutory Consultation**

Thank you for your feedback and comments, following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in December 2021.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to statutory consultation on proposals to introduce No Waiting At Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) around the junction of St Albans Road with Spring Gardens in the interests of road safety. A number of comments were received during the informal consultation in relation to vehicles parking on the footway. To clarify the waiting restrictions proposed will prohibit vehicles from parking on the road and the pavement next to where the lines are marked.

The statutory consultation period commences on Friday 18th February 2022. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX, or by email to [TID@watford.gov.uk](mailto:TID@watford.gov.uk). The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on Friday 11th March 2022.

All comments will be considered by Ward Councillors and officers prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
